Your tasks as a logistics operator in the warehouse:

- Picking goods and preparing orders for shipment.
- Working with a handheld scanner.
- Performing data entry on the computer and updating warehouse management systems.
- Ensuring compliance with safety and quality standards.
- Collaborating with team members to maintain an efficient workflow.

Your Benefits:

- Collective Agreement: The employment contract is based on the BAP/DGB collective agreement.
- Working Hours: The employment contract specifies a standard workweek of 35 hours.
- **Salary:** The gross hourly wage for this position is 14,83€ gross. Your monthly salary is 2249€ gross. Please note that deductions for social security contributions and taxes, in accordance with German regulations, will be applied to the gross salary.
- Contract Duration: We offer an indefinite employment contract.
- **Holiday Entitlement:** Employees are entitled to 25 days of paid holiday during the first year of employment, ensuring time for rest and well-being.
