The role involves delivering 1:1 and family-centered behavioural intervention to an 11-year-old child diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) for 2 days per week, and serving as a Supervisor for the remaining three days at our young-adults program, LifeMap.

Job description

- Conduct standardized behavioural assessments to identify skill strengths, learning needs, and behaviour reduction targets.
- Develop, implement, and monitor individualized Treatment Plans based on assessment results.
- Collect and analyse behavioural data daily to track progress and guide data-driven decisionmaking.
- Provide ongoing supervision, feedback, and training to therapists and team members as needed.
- Conduct parent meetings and provide consistent, actionable feedback to families.
- Coordinate care with other professionals (e.g., Speech Therapists, Occupational Therapists, Educators) to ensure a cohesive multidisciplinary approach.
- Arrange and facilitate extra-curricular and community-based learning opportunities to promote generalization and functional skills.
- Maintain open, professional communication and demonstrate flexibility across home, school, and Hand in Hand settings.

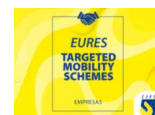
