- Plumbing: work on PVC, copper and steel pipe work
- Maintenance of and modifications to sanitation systems: water supply, waste and rainwater
- Modifications to compressed air and industrial water supply systems
- · Heating: distribution systems and associated equipment
- •Cooling: maintenance chilled water systems and direct expansion systems, handling of liquid refrigerants
- Ventilation: duct systems and associated equipment
- Wood and metal joinery (frames, doors and windows)
- · Load handling and related operations.

Qualifications / Experience:
