Job description	You teach children, young people and adults how to ski or snowboard in groups or in the form of individual lessons, or you can look after them on site on the practice slopes. You work in top ski regions.

Start date (and, if necessary, End date)	Beginning between October (Glacier regions in Tyrol) and December 2024 until March/April 2025
Salary	MINIMUM SALARY: depending on the qualification and experience, from 1.200 – 1.410 EUR gross upwards for 35 hours (net from about 1.020– 1.190 EUR upwards), overtime compensation is calculated additionally. Overpayment according to vocational training and professional skill is designated. Holiday and Cristmas allowance extra. Furthermore, free meals and lodging are offered.
Other information	Many employers are ready for overpayment if the skills are met by the worker (depending on education and work experience and is always negotiable with the employer). According to the Austrian labour market law, 13th and 14th salary are aliquot. Please do not forget that accommodation and meals are usually free of charge with the wage offer. (Maybe some ask for a small contribution for electricity, water and heating – e.g. 50 to 100 EUR). A work permit or free access to the Austrian labour market is required. If you are employed all year round, you are entitled to 25 working days of vacation. You acquire 2.08 vacation days per month.

Every foreign qualification must be recognised in Austria, even if it includes a CTT test.

The recognition takes about 5 working days in Tyrol.

In order to have a qualification tested and, if applicable, recognised for a job as a teacher at a Tyrolean ski school, applicants must submit an application for recognition to the competent district administrative authority in the district of their residence in Tyrol.

In order to be able to examine an application, all necessary proofs of qualification, such as in particular

- * Ski instructor examination certificate(s),
- * ski instructor certificate (e.g. ISIA, etc.)
- * If available, CTT certificate or IMI entry according to the Delegated Regulation of the European Commission, including proof of EURO test and EURO security test (is required for recognition as a diploma ski instructor examination).
- * Comprehensible proof of the duration and contents of the training or examination as a ski instructor (how many days and which theoretical and practical subjects did your training or examination as a ski instructor comprise?)
- * In German language (if necessary, translated in a comprehensible way).
