About the Job	
What is the position being offered?	Early Childhood Education Teacher (Finnish-speaking) at public daycare centers.
How many positions are available?	25 to 40 positions
Who is the employer ?	The City of Helsinki, Finland's largest employer The recruiting stage is assisted by RTK-Henkilöstöpalvelu, a Finnish recruiting company).
Where are the daycare centers located?	Across major districts of Helsinki city.
What are the working hours ?	Between 6:15 and 17:30; shifts are arranged based on family needs.
How is shift scheduling handled? (e.g., fixed or rotating shifts?)	Rotating shifts
What age group will I be working with?	Children aged 0–6 years.
How many children will I be responsible for? RATIO	In Finland, child-to-adult ratios are regulated by law. In Helsinki public daycare centers, typically there is one adult for every 4 children under 3 years old , and one adult for every 7 children aged 3–5 .
What is the average child-to-staff ratio?	Group sizes vary, but a typical group has 12–21 children , depending on their ages. You will always work in a team with other educators.

Will I have an assistant or work alone in the group?	You will always work as part of a team with other teachers and assistants. You will never be alone responsible for the whole group.
What are the main tasks of the position?	Planning, implementing, and assessing pedagogical activities; working closely with children, families, and colleagues.
What educational approaches are emphasized?	Play-based learning, full-day pedagogy, inclusivity, positive pedagogy, and child participation.
What materials and resources are available in the daycare center?	Daycare centers are well-equipped with educational toys, books, outdoor equipment, art supplies, and digital tools . Each center follows Helsinki's guidelines to offer rich learning environments.
Are the daycare centers specialized (e.g., music-oriented, forest daycare)?	No, we don't have daycares that are specialized in any particular activity as such. However, in all our daycares we adopt a full-day pedagogy and our staff members are encouraged to bring their own strengths, artistic or other talents and interests in the pedagogical work.
