DESCRIPCIÓN DE LAS FUNCIONES Y TAREAS A DESARROLLAR

The job consists of giving classes to students in a group, with a maximum of 8 students. The classes should always be interesting and dynamic, where there are always games or activities that are fun and attractive for the students.

All our classrooms have a small whiteboard and interactive screens. All of the course books are online and can be displayed on the interactive boards. The students will have the workbook associated with their course or, in the higher levels, the student book and workbook.

Every teacher has the teacher's material, usually online and physical, which greatly facilitates the preparation of the classes.

As a Cambridge preparation Centre all of our teachers must have proven experience in the preparation of the main suite Cambridge exams. Although not all students may take a Cambridge exam the majority do. That being said, we do not concentrate on just the exams but very much on fostering an environment which produces proficient users of the English language.

The most important principle for us is our concern for the quality of our teaching. To this end, we consider training and observation practices to be fundamental: we hold several training sessions throughout the course (always on working days), as well as peer observation plus feedback sessions.

One important part of a teachers job is providing feedback not only in the form of daily attendance and mock exam results but also in the feedback from the classes.
