The selected candidate will work in close collaboration with the ADB IT teams in Manila, Philippines.

Main duties and responsibilities

The incumbent will work under the direct supervision and guidance of the Head, Customer IT Resilience Team (OPBR) and Chief, Business Solutions Solutions Section (OPB) within the Operations Division (OP) and in close collaboration with the ADB IT technical teams. The incumbent could be requested to do any others tasks of similar level in related fields.
