# I&C Maintenance Technician

### Yours Tasks

Reporting to the Head of Group and working closely with the other technicians in the group, you will have the following duties:

- Preparing and carrying out preventive and corrective maintenance work and periodic testing and inspections on electronic equipment, including measuring channels and instrumentation and control systems.
- Updating and managing technical documentation, in particular electronic schematics and electrical drawings, ensuring that they are compliant and accurate.
- Carrying out performance tests and maintenance work on analogue circuit boards in the laboratory.
- Preparing maintenance and test procedures, supervising subcontractors and reporting on activities in compliance with current quality and safety standards.
- At a later date, and under the responsibility of a project manager: preparing and applying, or ensuring application of, technical documents enabling projects involving the creation or overhaul of installations to be carried out in compliance with quality and nuclear safety standards.

- You have a Level 4 or Level 5 qualification (HNC/HND, foundation degree or equivalent) or apprenticeship degree in electronics, electrical engineering or maintenance.
- You are capable of making modifications and improvements to instrumentation and control systems in an industrial environment, based on electrical and electronic drawings.
- You are proficient in the use of measuring instruments (oscilloscopes, multimeters, signal analysers) and signal generators.
- You have a service-oriented, practical attitude and are able to work both independently and as part of a team, while complying with safety regulations and standards.
